



Roll-Off Truck Driver

Summary of Position: UTEC Mattress Recycling is a social enterprise of UTEC, Inc. that employs young people who are in the process of improving their lives, and picks up mattresses from universities, municipalities and hotels across eastern Massachusetts. We are looking for a skilled and experienced driver to drive our 2006 Freightliner roll-off truck to and from pick-ups and to on-load and off-load containers .

Duties and Responsibilities: This position will be responsible for driving a 2006 Freightliner roll-off truck to client locations, and loading and unloading containers on and off the truck.

This individual will need to be comfortable working in a warehouse environment with a team and working with young men and women who are in the early stages of turning their lives away from poverty and violence to social and economic success. Specific duties are as follows:

- Drive the roll-off truck to and from pick-up or drop-off jobs in a safe and efficient manner
- Safely operate roll-off hook lift to on- and off-load containers
- Interact with customers when conducting pick-ups to ensure customer satisfaction
- Monitor truck performance and maintenance
- Recognize the role of youth work in the job. Contribute to the development of youth through conversations and demonstrate good work habits.

Qualifications:

- CDL License is REQUIRED.
- Minimum 2 years' experience driving similar sized vehicle
- Clean driving record
- Ability to complete a Bill of Lading accurately
- Team mentality - willing to chip in to help others
- Ability to communicate verbally with others, particularly customers
- Punctuality, consistency
- Ability to laugh at yourself

Schedule and Compensation: Hours are somewhat variable but usually start at 8am, with a minimum of 30 hours, Tuesdays through Saturdays. Paid on a per-job basis.
